**Schedule of Events**

**May 10<sup>th</sup>, 5:00 P.M. visit and snacks. 6:00 P.M. Dinner at the Armory, also will be giving out shirts, mugs and hats.**

**May 11<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.**

**May 12<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.**

**We are going to let family fish again. This is limited only to Mother, Father, Husband, Wife, Brother, Sister, Son, or Daughter.**

**RULES INTERPRETATIONS:** The tournament committee is solely responsible for the interpretation and enforcement of tournament rules. Its decision will be final in all instances. All protests must be turned into the Tournament Director no later than 15 minutes after the closing of the scales. All protests must be in writing.

**REGISTRATION:** Entries must be received by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 before the event! Starting positions are determined by a random drawing of numbers.

**SCORING:** The tournament limit is 6 bass, 12 inches or longer. **A dead fish will not be weighed for lunger.** In the event of a tie, the team with the overall big bass will be determined the winner.

**TOURNAMENT HOURS:** Official practice day is May 10<sup>th</sup>, Tournament days will be the 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup>, the tournament will run from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on May 11<sup>th</sup>. On the 12<sup>th</sup>, the tournament will run from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

**PENALTIES:** All participants must check in with tournament officials at the official check-in site. Participants arriving late for weigh-in will be penalized 1 pound per minute. Any participants arriving 10 minutes late will loose the entire weight of their fish for that day. **If a dead fish is weighed, 8 ounces will be deducted per dead fish and a short fish is a 1 pound penalty plus the weight of the short fish. If sight fishing, only fish hooked inside the mouth will be an acceptable catch. All those hooked outside the mouth, must be released immediately.**

**By signing this form, I agree to hold the tournament director and tournament committee harmless should any injury or damage result to me or my property. I also agree to abide by the above rules.**
